It is nearly impossible for those who do not have financial resources to return to New Orleans, where housing costs have skyrocketed since Hurricane Katrina. By working with Berean Presbyterian Church to rebuild these apartments, we can provide Section 8 housing in a neighborhood where it is desperately needed. The rents generated will also help a historic, African American congregation rebuild and sustain their ministry of mission and outreach in one of the poorest communities of New Orleans. The recovery of New Orleans depends on congregations such as Berean, where neighborhood ministries are critical to the life of the community.
